## Conference Center Roof at the Chile Training Center

For several years now, we have rented tents (as pictured to the right) for events held at the Chile Training Center. Over the past few months, we have been developing a plan to install a large metal roof over the entire exterior patio at the Training Center. This metal structure will allow us to host training events and conferences throughout the year with a maximum seating capacity of over 300 people! The total material cost for the roof is
